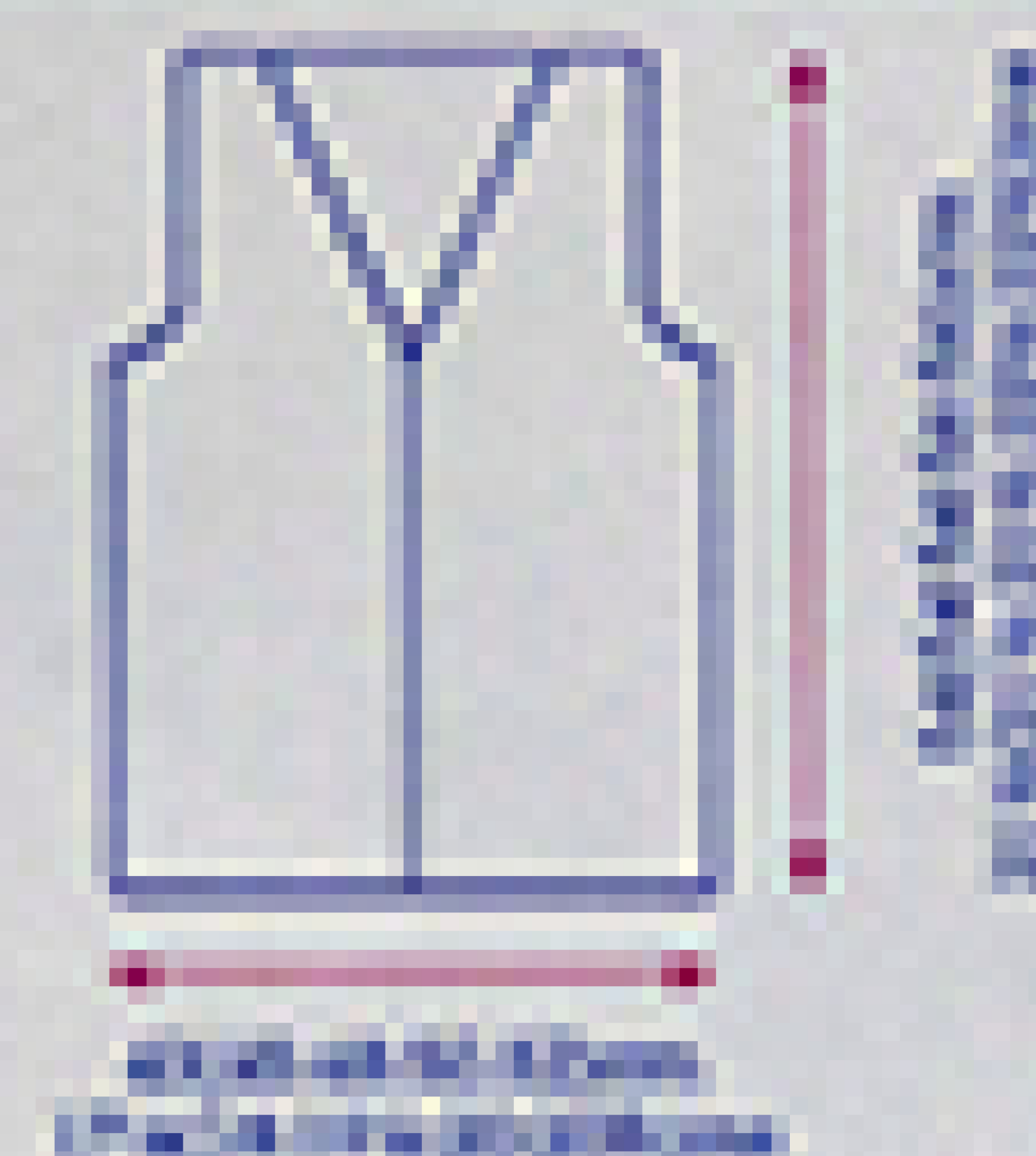

KING TUT WAISTCOAT



MATERIALS

400-450-500 (300-400)g of King Tut
 Wool or 4mm (15 1/4) knitting needles
 Wool of 4mm (15 1/4) knitting needles
 2 Buttons

FINISH

Wash and dry flat to dimensions as given over at all
 using steam (20 to needles)
 Block flat to meet to dimensions as given over post
 using steam (20 to needles)

BACK

With 4mm (15 to needles, cast on 72 (74-82) stitches

Knit 2 rows

1st part row (right side) Knit with long from round needle below to end.

2nd part row (wrong side) Knit leaving the cable loop drop from needle to make it long at the end.

Knit 2 rows

These 4 rows form the part.

Rep the last 4 rows until the back measure 27cm (10 3/4) from cast on edge, ending with a 2nd part row

3rd row 10 (10-11) *knit, 2 (2-3) cables from 1 to end, 1 (1-1) cable knit to end, 2 (2-3) to 2 cables

Knit one row

Starting with a 3rd row cast on at all until back measure 34cm (13 1/2) from cast on edge, ending with a wrong side row

shape shoulders

Cast off one at the beg of the next 2 rows, 74 (72-80) to 6 rows

Over one at all ends end of next and 2 last 4th rows, 74 (74-80) to 6 rows

Cast without shaping at all until shoulder measures

20cm (8) to 22cm (8 1/2) from from cast on shoulder shaping, ending with a wrong side row

shape shoulders

Cast off 1 (1-2) stitches at the beg of the next 2 rows

Cast off entire 74 (74-80) to 6 rows

LEFT FRONT

With 4mm (15 to needles, cast on 36 (38-42) stitches

Knit 2 rows

1st part row (right side) Knit with long from round needle below to end.

2nd part row (wrong side) Knit leaving the cable loop drop from needle to make it long at the end.

Knit 2 rows

These 4 rows form the part.

Rep the last 4 rows until the left front measure 27cm (10 3/4) from cast on edge, ending with a 2nd part row

3rd row 10 (10-11) *knit, 2 (2-3) cables from 1 to end, 1 (1-1) cable knit to end, 2 (2-3) to 2 cables

Cast on one at beg of next row, knit to end, 40 (40-44) to 6 rows

Knit one row

Next row 4th part to end

Starting with a 3rd row, cast on at all with edge knit on at all until left front measure 34cm (13 1/2) from cast on edge, ending with a wrong side row

shape shoulders and neck

Cast off one at the beg of the next row, 40 (40-44) to 6 rows

Next row 4th row from cast on a button post to end, 40 (40-44) to 6 rows

Over one at all shoulder edge of next and 2 last 4th rows of the same line

1st row at all back edge of next and every 4th row until there are

10 (10-11) stitches

Cast without shaping until shoulder measure 20cm (8) to 22cm (8 1/2) from from cast on shoulder shaping, ending with a wrong side row

Cast off

RIGHT FRONT

With 4mm (15 to needles, cast on 36 (38-42) stitches

BUTTONBAND EDGING

Join shoulder seams, with right side facing and 4mm (15 to needles, knit two from button to left front

Starting with a 3rd row, cast on at all until edging the up left side to centre back, ending with a wrong side row

Cast off top with two plates

Mark positions for 2 buttons along front opening edge. 1st one 1cm from cast on edge and second one at button before cast of neck shaping

BUTTONHOLE EDGING

With right side facing and 4mm (15 to needles, knit two from button to right front

Starting with a 3rd row, cast on at all until edging measure 1cm from cast on edge, ending with a wrong side row

Buttonhole row (2 rows, 4 rows, 4)

Cast on at all working buttonhole to correspond with position marked for button on buttonhole edging, until edging the up right side to centre back, ending with a wrong side row

Cast off, knit cast off edge of buttonhole edging to button band edging, slip with two plates

ARMHOLE EDGING

With right side facing and 4mm (15 to needles, pick up and knit 10 (10-11) stitches up one armhole edge, pick up and knit 10 (10-11) to 11 stitches along other side, 100 (100-100) to 12 rows

Knit 2 rows

Cast off

TO MAKE UP

Join side seams, button and sew buttons into place

GENERAL PATTERN INFORMATION

In the patterns the instructions are given for the smallest size, with larger sizes in round brackets, where only one figure or instruction is given, this applies to all sizes. Where all directions under square brackets the number of times stated.

We cannot accept responsibility for the finished garment if any parts other than the one specified is used.

The quantities of yarn are based on average requirements and therefore are approximate.

ABBREVIATIONS

all: all round

beg: beginning

end: end of row

eve: end of row

evn: even row

fol: following

g all: quarter stitch, every row knit

kn: knit

kn2: knit 2

kn1: make one at beg by picking up the loop lying between a just worked and next to end

kn2tog: knit two together and knit to end

kn2tbl: knit two together

kn4: knit 4

kn6: knit 6

kn8: knit 8

kn10: knit 10

kn12: knit 12

kn14: knit 14

kn16: knit 16

kn18: knit 18

kn20: knit 20

kn: knit round needle to make a knit
